EXAMINATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS
June 2019

A. STUDENT EXAMINATION SCHEDULE

It is the student's responsibility to note and record the **DATE**, the **TIME**, and the **PLACE** of each exam. Schedules are posted in various locations around the school as well as distributed digitally.

B. EXAM MATERIALS

Come prepared with pencils, pens, ruler, eraser, calculator and/or any other materials indicated by your subject teacher. Leave jackets and other belongings in your locker or at the side or front of the room.

C. EQUIPMENT/ELECTRONIC DEVICES

No books, backpacks, cell phones or personal electronic devices will be allowed on your person. Possessing these items while in an exam room may be grounds for improper exam conduct. **A student caught using any of these devices will be deemed to be cheating and a mark of zero could result.** These items should be placed in your locker **prior to writing an exam.**

D. STUDENT ABSENCE

Students who miss a summative evaluation or formal examination for illness must present a medical certificate and a letter from their parents to administration within 1 day.

E. LATES

Examinations begin promptly. Ideally you should be prepared to write at least 15 minutes prior to exam time. Late arrivals should sign in at the office and will not likely be given additional time.

F. TEXTBOOK RETURN

All textbooks or other borrowed resources (including library books and team uniforms) should be returned prior to writing your exam in that course. If you have lost a textbook or other item, arrangements should be made to pay for that item with the office BEFORE writing the exam for that course. Report cards will not be issued for any students with outstanding resources or unpaid fines.

G. BUS SCHEDULE

Buses will run according to their normal schedules.

H. HALL ACCESS

The library and cafeteria will be accessible during exams. All halls will be out of bounds from 9:00 am - 11:00 am. The 3rd floor English hallway will be out of bounds from 8:50 am - 12:30 pm. Please make sure you obtain what you need from your locker outside of these times.
